



## Town of Winnipeg Beach BY-LAW #12/2004

### BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF WINNIPEG BEACH PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATING OF SKATEBOARDING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF WINNIPEG BEACH

#### Spheres of Jurisdiction

- 232(1) A Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters: . . .
- (a) the safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of property;
  - (b) people, activities and things in, on or near a public place or a place open to the public, including parks, municipal roads, recreation centres, restaurants, facilities, retail stores, malls, and private clubs and facilities that are exempt from municipal taxation;

**AND WHEREAS** persons skateboarding on sidewalks and roads create pedestrian and vehicular hazards throughout the community.

**AND WHEREAS** Council views it in the best interests of the Town of Winnipeg Beach regulating skateboarding in Winnipeg Beach:

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED** as a By-Law of the Town of Winnipeg Beach as follows:

1. THAT no skateboarding shall be permitted within the Town of Winnipeg Beach on any public roads or sidewalks including the Winnipeg Beach Boardwalk and the Winnipeg Beach Outdoor Stage
2. THAT any person who contravenes the provisions of this By-Law may be arrested without warrant by any Peace Officer having jurisdiction within the Town of Winnipeg Beach.
3. THAT the person who contravenes the provisions set out in this By-Law shall, for each offence, be liable upon summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not greater than \$300.00 plus costs. Each contravention of this By-Law shall be deemed to be a separate offence.
